1. Rounds and Venues

The series will always begin with the Spring Cup and end with the Autumn Trophy. The Autumn Trophy (the King Bhumibol Trophy) will be presented by OKDIA for the first time in 2020 and will be used for the closing regatta of the Euro Series each year, wherever that is held.

2 Rules

Each event shall be defined by its own Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, including any National Authority Prescriptions.

3. Media Rights

By participating in any event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority, OKDIA and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

4. Identification and Advertising

When provided by the organizing authority, boats or competitors shall carry, display or wear series advertising.

5. Format

4.1 The series will consist of five events

4.2 The scoring system for Rounds will be as follows: 1st: 200 points; 2nd 195 points; 3rd 190 points; 4th 189 points; 5th 188 points etc.

4.3 The scoring system for Final will be as follows: 1st: 300 points; 2nd 295 points; 3rd 290 points; 4th 289 points; 5th 288 points etc.

4.4 A competitor's best three scores will be added together to make its final score.

4.5 Any event not competed in shall score points equal to the lowest score of any competitor in any event in the series, minus 5.

4.6 Competitors will be allocated to Gold, Silver and Bronze fleets depending on their results in previous years. Gold fleet sailors will be those who scored a top 20% in any major event in 2019. Counting major events will be decided by OKDIA. Bronze fleet sailors will be those who consistently scored in the bottom 50% of the selected regattas. Silver Fleet sailors will be everyone else. This may be adjusted once initial allocations have been made.

6. Prizes

The winner of the series will be awarded the OKDIA Euro Series Trophy.

The top 10 shall receive prizes from OKDIA.

Prizes shall also be awarded to the top three in the Silver and Bronze fleets

Additional prizes may be awarded through the fleet as appropriate.
